A modest snowfall Friday covered the fairgrounds just in time for the Rensselaer County SnowRidersí third annual snocross competitions while sunny skies and cold temperatures lingering around freezing welcomed hundreds of racers and spectators to the two-day event.

The competition is part of the Rock Maple Racing circuit, which runs races throughout the northeast from December to April. 
